ANNUAL REPORT – 2018-2019

Educated women are the real source of happiness in the family, society and country. With this objective KTR women's college was established in 1970 and has been catering to the educational needs of the girl students especially from rural and economically weaker sections. Besides the academic activities the college is encouraging students co-curricular activities.

Our academic calendar for this year started on 06.06.2018 after summer vacation. A total of 370 students were enrolled in different courses. Besides me, 23 teaching staff, 7 non-teaching staff, contingent staff constitute the institution's functionaries. This year our attention is focused on NAAC SSR preparation for II cycle and has submitted it on 03.02.2019.

RESULTS: The first batch of CBCS pattern students went out in March, 2018 examination and the results of Intermediate and Degree courses are as follows:

Sr. Intermediate :	51%
I Degree :	50%
II Degree :	63%
III Degree :	68%

Some of the passed out students (nearly 30% to 35%) progressed to higher studies (PG; B.Ed., M.B.A/M.C.A.) and some are preparing for competitive examinations.

This year is full of activities and our teaching staff honed up their knowledge/skills by attending/presenting papers in International, National seminars, workshops and publishing articles in Journals. Guest lectures by eminent teachers from other institutions are arranged by Departments of Chemistry, Zoology, Politics, English etc.

Field trips for students to nearby industries, places of historical, cultural importance are arranged by a few departments which enrich their practical knowledge. Besides conventional teaching methods staff are adopting ICT enabled methods using Digital Class rooms, PPT presentation, making use of U-tube lessons, Mana TV recorded lessons etc. These have a positive impact on student centered learning and students are also encouraged to present PPTs, seminars, GDS etc. Internet facility is accessible to students in library and computer lab. Inlib net facility available in the library is helping the students to free down loading of books.

The IQAC arranged various awareness programmes on personality development, leadership qualities, career guidance, NAAC etc. Career Guidance Cell of the college conducted awareness talks by the people of reputed institutions who appraised them about Educational Career opportunities. The Women Development Cell (WDC) and NSS units celebrated World Yoga Day, Teachers Day, Freshers Day, Ozone Preservation Dy, Anti Drugs Day, Youth Day etc. Rallies in connection with World Aids Day, National Integration Day, Voters Day are conducted on 1.12.2018, 30.10.2018 and 25.1.2019 respectively. WDC conducted Dental Camp to the students on 20th and 21st June 2018. Breast Cancer awareness campaign through pamphlets is another significant extension activity. An Inter Collegiate Youth festival is celebrated in co-ordination with A.P. Department of Youth Affairs on 25.8.2018. Parents Meet was conducted on 20.1.2019.

The Eco Club of the college has taken up Bio-cultivation in the campus, and Eco club, NSS and NCC units are conducting Swatchata programme once in a month. Plastic free Campus Maintenance, Matti Vinayaka idol distribution, Ozone preservation awareness programmes are taken up to promote Environmental consciousness.

The NSS volunteers are actively involved in outreach programmes like JBMV, ODF Survey, Grama Darshini. The NCC unit of the college is revived this year and theory and practice classes are going on. Our students participation and achievements in sports activities are also quite encouraging. Two students, Ms. Pushpa and Ms. Anjali represented in South Zone Kabbadi and South Zone Cricket Tournaments.

This year 95% of students got Government Scholarships and three of our Intermediate students got merit scholarships.

Physical & Academic Facilities:

Safe drinking water, Sanitary napkins are provided to students. Study hours, remedial classes, bridge courses are conducted for backwards students, freshers respectively. Incentives certainly boost the morale of the students and various awards, prizes are instituted for this purpose. Donors from outside also instituted prizes in cash & kind. The details will be given during prize distribution.

Before I conclude my report I would like to thank our honourable President Dr.S. Surendra Nath Reddy garu, our beloved Secretary, Sri P.
